Michelle Hinder (CCCA - FASA)

I've been involved with the cat fancy since 2006 when I purchased my first Burmese show cat. In 2007 I registered my prefix 'Leewood' and have been a dedicated Burmese breeder since then. I began working at shows early on, first clerking then stewarding, and running shows, serving on club committees.

Fast forward to my adult life, and I purchased our first cream Burmese in 2006. I knew nothing about standards or showing, but gave it a try, and was addicted. I registered my prefix Leewood in 2007 and began my breeding program, which has been very successful, producing many Supremes, from the Royal Adelaide Show to the CCCA National Show. One of my favourite girls is featured on the CCCA website as one of very few Burmese to achieve her CCCA National Show title. In 2019, my prefix won Group 3 Breeder of the Year, something I'm very proud of.

I've worked in most aspects of our cat fancy, from clerking, to running shows, and began stewarding early on. I thoroughly enjoy stewarding, and if I'm not judging, you'll always find me in my white coat handling beautiful cats.

In 2015 FASA ran a judging course, starting with Group 2, where I was qualified in 2017.

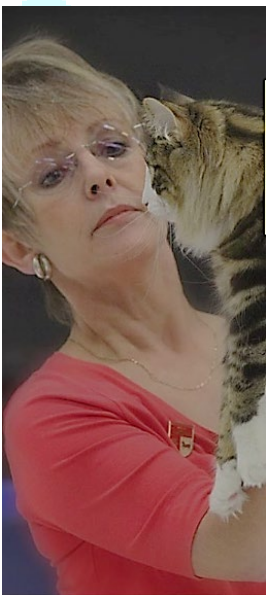
From there I continued into Group 3 to be a qualified All Shorthair CCCA Judge. In 2022 I completed my Group 1 probation to become a fully qualified CCCA All breeds Judge.

The Cat Fancy is a passion of mine that I share with my kitten buyers, and I actively encourage new exhibitors to attend shows and participate in our lovely hobby.

In my 'other life' I help my husband run our horse training business WH Performance Horses, where we specialise in training and breeding elite reining horses and cow horses. My life revolves around animals, only the size of the pooper scooper varies!

Lesley Morgan (ACF - CAT)



I began in 1964 with chinchilla Persians. (Comyn) As my parents became involved with Burmese (Jindivik, 1965) and then imported the first British Shorthair breeding pair into Australasia (Redwyton, 1969) was involved with those breeds. Also in 1967 I acquired a tabby point Siamese, breeding the first lilac tabby point on the Australian bench in Jan, 1969 (Merriminx). Seeing my first Exotic Shorthair in the flesh at a show in Holland in the early 80's, I pioneered that breed in Australia for some 16 generations. I also owned the ultimate show pony tawny Abyssinian superstar neuter from 1997. My current relationship: 2 pensioner desexed Exotics, a rescued spay and an inherited German Shepherd.

I have held various positions in the cat fancy: Tasmanian clubs since 1965, head tutor judge Tasmania since 1975, all positions but Treasurer with CAT Inc., ACF (Inc.) Acting President, International Liaison Officer, Editor or co-editor yearbooks 1970's, 1980's, 1996 to present day, ACF (Inc.) delegate to World Cat Congress for 12 of its 16 meetings, inaugural Treasurer, ACF Judges' Guild, Secretary and Editor, "Felijudge". Show manager, ACF (Inc.) National Shows 1987, 1983, 1999, 2007 and 2012. Show Convenor, 2014 ACF National.

Most, multiple times: New Zealand, Singapore, Malaysia (West) and Sarawak, Indonesia (Jakarta Raya, Surabaya), Finland, Sweden, Norway, Holland, UK, France, Italy, Austria, Germany, Denmark, Latvia, Poland, Czech Republic, Slovakia, Japan, South Africa USA and Thailand.

CLASSES FOR EVENTS

EXPLANATION ON KITTENS

All kittens must be individually registered to enter in F7/M7 and F9/M9 classes. All kittens in a litter must be **recorded** to enter in a litter class. F3/M3 and F5/M5 individual classes providing they are under 5 months old (over 5 months they would not be eligible for a litter class) This is to allow exhibitors to obtain a Judges' opinion on relative merits before keeping or selling particular kittens and thence registering them under their individual names.

PEDIGREED KITTEN CLASSES

Events are for competition in each breed colour.

Exhibits over 12 weeks and under 9 months on day of Show.

(Kittens can only be entered in their respective age group including neuters)

F3/M3 - Kittens 12 weeks and under 3 Calendar Months.

F5/M5 - Kittens 3 Calendar Months and under 5 Calendar Months.

F7/M7 - Kittens 5 Calendar Months and under 7 Calendar Months.

F9/M9 - Kittens 7 Calendar Months and under 9 Calendar Months.

LIT. - Litter of Kittens - All living progeny of one birth 12 weeks and under 5 Calendar Months old on day of show. Total number of kittens entered to be shown on entry form.

In the event of the death of a kitten between closure of entries and day of show, a veterinary certificate certifying cause of death must be furnished to the Veterinary Surgeon officiating on day of show.

Note - All litters are judged in their respective groups.

PEDIGREED CAT ENTIRE CLASSES

F.O. - Female Open. M.O. - Male Open

All entire exhibits that **have not attained any championship title**

CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

Championship and Premiership events are grouped as per the frames in the Breed Table

FCH. - Female Champion. MCH. - Male Champion

(Cats that have been granted the title of "Champion" after winning 4 Challenge Certificates in **Open** Challenge Classes under at least 3 different judges).

FGC - Female Grand Champion. MGC - Male Grand Champion

(Cats that have been granted the title of "Grand Champion" after winning 4 Challenge Certificates in the **Champion** Class under at least 3 different judges).

Bronze FGC - Bronze Female Grand Champion.

Bronze MGC - Bronze Male Grand Champion

(Cats that have been granted the title of "Bronze Grand Champion" after winning 4 Challenge Certificates in the **Grand Champion** Class under at least 3 different judges).

Silver FGC - Silver Female Grand Champion.

Silver MGC - Silver Male Grand Champion

(Cats that have been granted the title of "Silver Grand Champion" after winning 4 Challenge Certificates in the **Bronze Grand Champion** Class under at least 3 different judges).

Gold FGC - Gold Female Grand Champion.

Gold MGC - Gold Male Grand Champion

(Cats that have been granted the title of "Gold Grand Champion" after winning 4 Challenge Certificates in the **Silver Grand Champion** Class under at least 3 different judges).

(Cats that have been granted title of "Gold Grand Champion" will be eligible for **SAPPHIRE, RUBY, EMERALD and DIAMOND** after winning 6 Challenge Certificates under at least 4 different judges).

PEDIGREED CAT DESEXED CLASSES

DFC. - Desexed Female Cat. DMC. - Desexed Male Cat

All desexed female & desexed male exhibits over 9 months old on the day of show **that have not attained any championship title**

PREMIERSHIP CLASSES

FPR - Female Premier. MPR - Male Premier

(Desexed cats that have been granted the title of "Premier" after winning 4 Award of Merit Certificates in the **Open Desexed** Class under at least 3 different judges).

FGPR. - Female Grand Premier MGPR. - Male Grand Premier

(Desexed cats that have been granted the title of "Grand Premier" after winning 4 Award of Merit Certificates in the **Premier Class** under at least 3 different judges).

Bronze FGPR - Bronze Female Grand Premier

Bronze MGPR - Bronze Male Grand Premier

(Cats that have been granted the title of "Bronze Grand Premier" after winning 4 Award of Merit Certificates in the **Grand Premier** Class under at least 3 different judges).

Silver FGPR - Silver Female Grand Premier

Silver MGPR - Silver Male Grand Premier

(Cats that have been granted the title of "Silver Grand Champion" after winning 4 Award of Merit Certificates in the **Bronze Grand Premier** Class under at least 3 different judges).

Gold FGPR - Gold Female Grand Premier

Gold MGPR - Gold Male Grand Premier

(Cats that have been granted the title of "Gold Grand Premier" after winning 4 Award of Merit Certificates in the **Silver Grand Premier** Class under at least 3 different judges).

Desexed cats that have been granted title of "Gold Grand Premier" will be eligible for **SAPPHIRE, RUBY, EMERALD and DIAMOND** after winning 6 Award of Merit Certificates under at least 4 different judges).

CCCA AWARDS

All entire female & male cats that have been granted the title of Champion are automatically entered into CCCA Award classes. (Male & Female separately).

All desexed female & male cats that have been granted the title of Premier or Champion are automatically entered into CCCA Award classes. (Male & Female separately).

COMPANION CAT CLASSES

ALL GROUP 4 EXHIBITS MUST BE DESEXED.

As from 1 January 2000 all Part/Non Pedigree and Domestic kittens and cats will be referred to as Companion Cats/Kittens and will be judged together.

Kittens and Adults will still be judged separately.

C.M.C.L. - Companion Male Cat - Longhair
